Cascade Sports Car Club 2020 Bud Kinder Memorial Outstanding Member

Dear Members,



Each year the club votes on an outstanding membership designated as the “Bud Kinder Memorial Trophy for Outstanding Membership”. Selection is based on the candidate’s contribution, participation, loyalty, and dedication to the club during the year. The winner is presented with a perpetual trophy that they are allowed to keep for a year.

Typically we select a committee to gather prospective nominees from eligible members. That committee would then accept nominations. Due to the lack of regular meetings and other club gatherings, we need to alter the procedure a bit this year. I am asking you all to participate via phone, email, text, snail mail, or whatever means you desire. **We need to have a list of nominees by October 3rd latest.** That list then goes out to the membership for voting approximately October 15. Votes need to be back by November 7th for tabulation. The winner (most votes) is then chosen and will receive their award.

I have included an excerpt from our Bylaws that better explains the procedures/requirements. Some of these procedures are being slightly altered from a typical year. The dates stated for Nominations and Voting represent our regular General meeting dates.

2. Perpetual trophies will be presented at the Annual Banquet. These will be retained until the following Annual Banquet. At this time, the previous winners will be presented with a trophy, which they may keep.

A. BUD KINDER MEMORIAL TROPHY FOR OUTSTANDING MEMBERSHIP: A committee consisting of the President, Membership Chairperson and a member selected from the floor, will be formed at the first General meeting of the year. The committee will be responsible for presenting a list of nominees and their contributions to consider for presentation of the nominations for the Board of Directors.

This list will be published prior to their presentation to the club. At this time, nominations will be accepted from the floor when accompanied by a written statement of the candidates’ contributions. The following criteria are to be considered in nominating outstanding membership candidates:

- (1) The candidate’s contribution for the current calendar year.**
- (2) Participation in a variety of club activities.**
- (3) Loyalty and dedication to Cascade Sports Car Club.**
- (4) The prior year’s contributions are not to be considered for this award.**

As you can see, part of the procedure requires that when you nominate someone, you provide a short written statement explaining why you feel this member should receive the award. Please think about and consider who among your fellow Cascade members is deserving of this award and submit their names and qualifications to me. If you have questions or would like assistance with the process, please contact me. I look forward to your response.

2021 Board of Directors Nominations



Dear Cascade Sports Car Club members,

It's once again time to start the process of electing your 2021 Cascade Sports Car Club Board of Directors.

The club has 8 BOD's (plus 1 alternate). We elect 4 new members each year for a two year term. 4 are new and 4 return for their second year. In a typical year, we elect a 5 member nominating committee at the August General Meeting. Four committee members are selected from the membership and the fifth is the Membership Chairperson (me). The job of the committee is to find prospective new BOD candidates. Nominations are accepted through early October.

For review, I have included a brief summary of the usual process (taken from the bylaws).

A 5 member nominating committee with one member being the membership chair shall be elected by the membership at the August General Meeting. The committee is to present a slate of (whenever possible) 8 nominees at the September Gen. Mtg. Additional nominations can be accepted from the floor at the September and October meetings. A brief summary of each nominee's qualifications is to be provided on the ballot. Prior to October 15th the ballots are mailed to the membership to be voted on. Votes are counted at the November meeting and the new board is announced.

If you have questions regarding eligibility or want further information on the process, you can check out the Bylaws on the Cascade web site.

Due to the club not being able to hold regular meetings, we are going to have to make adjustments to the process. We are going to have to do this via phone, email, etc. We will use the calendar dates that represent our General meeting dates.

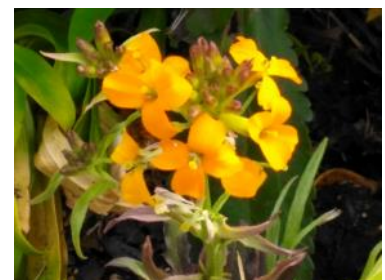
Nominations must be sent, e-mailed, or phoned in to Steve Powell no later than October 3rd.

2/4/8 Hour Races Saturday October 17, 2020 at PIR

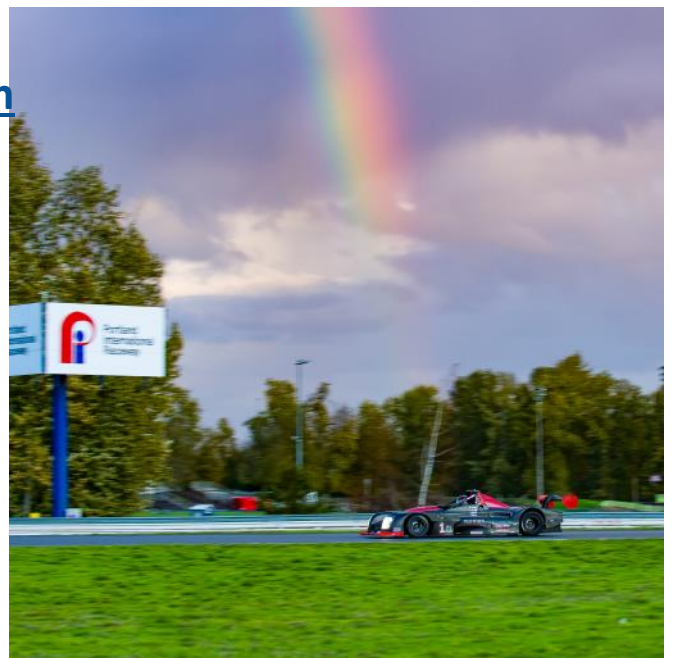

Subject: Help at the Enduro as a pit crew member or at a turn station

Cascade Members,

Our final race of the season is coming up Saturday, October 17th at PIR - *The Cascade Festival of Endurance* which features three races in one. There is a 2 hour, 4 hour, and an 8 hour race (which all start at the same time). We are looking for about five volunteers to help crew for teams that may not have a crew which would prevent them from entering the race. This would be for the 2 hour and 4 hour portions of the race figuring that teams running the 8 hour would have enough drivers and crew to get them through.

What you would do: We would be looking for people to refuel the car and to man a fire bottle during refueling. The team(s) you are crewing for would provide all the necessary supplies (gas, fire bottle, etc). Teams may also like the oil checked or possibly tires changed during a pit stop. You would not be doing any sort of mechanical work, this would be more to facilitate what goes on during a normal pit stop. Ideally we would need at least two people who have fire suits as the person re-fueling the car needs to be in "driver" gear.

Time commitment: The race starts at noon with the four hour ending at 4:00pm. Probably should arrive at the track by 10:00am to meet with the rest of your crew and the team or drivers you will be helping. The bridge will be open so parking on the south side of the track is an option so you'll be able to leave after the race or there is also a track crossing at 5:30pm to let cars out of the north paddock if you decide to park on the inside.

If we can get five people to commit we'll advertise to the drivers that Cascade providing a crew for them is an option. We'll give drivers/teams until Wednesday, October 14th to let us know if they are in need of a crew. If we don't receive any requests by then, your services won't be needed and we thank you for volunteering to help.

Other opportunities to volunteer: We are sometimes in need of pit marshals (they help monitor pit stops for safety). We are always in need of flaggers at the turns. Even if you are able to help for part of a day we would love to have the help. All day flaggers are at the track from 8:00am - 8:00pm for this event. Yeah it's a long day but it's fun!!
