

QUICK OVERVIEW OF CLASSES – Section 13 of the ICSCC Competition Regulations

Sports Racing – Section 1302. Purpose built racecars with closed wheels, often open cockpit

CC4 – Section 1303. Caterham 7 Spec class

Formula – Section 1304. Purpose built open wheel race cars. Various classes

GT/Super Production – Sections 1306 & 1307. Highly modified, often tube frame cars. Cars classed by performance and by engine displacement.

Improved Production – Section 1306. Moderately modified production cars. Reference SCCA GCR for allowable modifications and a listing of eligible cars

ITE – Section 1308. Open modifications for cars other than Sports Racers and Formula cars.

American Sedan – Section 1309. Class for cars like Camaros, Mustangs, and Firebirds. Reference SCCA GCR for allowable modifications and a listing of eligible cars

SpecE46 – Section 1310. Class for 2001-2006 BMW 330 (E46 series) cars. Reference SE46 website for rules.

Spec Miata – Section 1312. Class for 1990-2005 Mazda Miatas

Club Spec Miata – Section 1313. Class for 1990-1997 Mazda Miatas

Club Rabbit – Section 1314. Class for 1975-1980 VW Rabbits

PRO-7 – Section 1315. Class for 1979-1985 Mazda RX-7s

PRO44 – Section 1316. Class for 1983-1988 Porsche 944/924 cars

PRO-3 – Section 1317. Class for 1984-1991 BMW 325 (E30 series) cars

ITX – Section 1318. Class for Improved Touring cars (same as below Section 1319)

Improved Touring – Section 1319. Similar to Conference Production. Slightly modified from stock. Reference SCCA GCR for allowable modifications and a listing of eligible cars

Honda Touring – Section 1320. Class for various 1988-2006 Hondas

Sport Touring – Section 1321. Based on horsepower to weight ratio. Chassis, brakes, and aero modifications much more liberal than Improved Touring

Conference Touring 4 (CT4) – Section 1322. Various classes grouped together like SCCA T4, Improved Touring, and PRO3.
