
The very large hole in our annual Social gathering was the absence of Linda Blackburn. She will be missed terribly. At this time, there will not be a memorial service for Linda.

The race groups have been rearranged for 2026 which will affect reserved car numbers. If two drivers have the same car number in the same group, priority will be given to the driver who has been licensed with ICSCC the longest.

GROUP 1: SPO,M,U, ST1, SM, CSM, HT, CR

GROUP 2: PRO3, PRO7, PRO44, ITX

GROUP 3: CLUB CHOICE (Club's may elect to use this how they would like or can elect to not use it at all)

GROUP 4: GT1,2,3, AS, ITE, SST, ST, SE46

GROUP 5: ITA,B,C,S, GTL, CT4, E,F,H IMPROVED PRODUCTION, ST2, ST3, ST4, ST5

GROUP 6: CF, FF, FA, FM, FC, FV, FL, B,C,D,E,F SPORTS RACER, CC4, NOVICE O/W

A summary of the groups/classes - Groups 1 and 2 saw the biggest change, Group 4 is unchanged, Group 5 is relatively unchanged except for ST2-5 were added, and Groups 3 & 6 have been permanently combined.

Discussion was had about listing available or taken reserved car numbers on the ICSCC website. A proposal will be brought to the Spring Meeting.

Cascade's proposal for allowing the combination of groups for qualifying was passed 4-0. 703.A The grouping of classes for ~~qualifying and~~ racing shall be designated for race groups in 703 D. and E. Preferably before the next race event. With no penalties of any kind to their current race weekend or future race weekends.</p> <p>If a participant chooses to not make changes to comply with the particular rule infraction. Or if they disagree and or would like to clarify the findings. An official protest can be filed with the ICSCC Stewards to come up with an official ruling on the situation.</p>

Removal of material (lightening) beyond the minimum to accomplish this task is prohibited. ...

## February 21 Rally School

Jump start the 2026 rally season with Rally School. Go for a scenic country drive and learn to play the game that takes you places. Rally school is for all levels of rally skill – from beginners to season winners.

Rally School is two-part. The first part is virtual rally school on Friday evening, Feb. 20. The second part is the road rally. The rally starts Saturday morning, Feb. 21, with first car out at 10:01 a.m. The virtual rally school and the practice rally are designed to help you learn how to play the game that takes you places.

An entry team consists of a street-legal vehicle, licensed and insured driver, navigator, and a smart device (cell phone or tablet) running the Competitor Ricta GPS Checkpoints app. The app is free.

Entry fee is \$25 per team for CSCC members, \$35 per team for non-members.

## Geargrinders Report to the Board – 2025 Yearend and 2026 Budget Approval

### Look back at 2025

Overall, the 2025 rally season was successful. Attendance averaged 18.3 entries per event, the same as last season. The event with the most entries was the Rally School in February with 28 entries. The Mountains to the Sea Rally had 23 entries, and the Ghouls Gambol Rally had 22 entries. The six events in the Saturday Rally Series averaged 15.3 entries per rally, down from 17.5 entries per rally last season.


Prepaid entry packages continued to be popular in 2025. Twelve Season Tickets provided a guaranteed number of entries at each rally, and they promoted club membership since membership is required to purchase a prepaid entry package.

The Geargrinders 2025 season ended with a small loss of about \$400. We anticipated a smaller loss, but we were not expecting an 18% increase in insurance cost. The 2026 Geargrinders budget request assumes insurance cost will remain stable, which we hope is true.

### Look ahead at 2026

Keeping Cascade rallies accessible, affordable, and fun to run continue to be goals for the 2026 season. Attendance is projected to remain stable at 18.4 teams per rally in 2026. The season is expected to end with a small profit, but much depends on attendance which is impacted by outreach as well as fuel costs and competition with other activities.

Nine rallies are planned in 2026. Once a month, from February through October, the 2026 Cascade Geargrinders road rally program will offer a Saturday drive in the country while playing the game that takes you places.

Although event dates have not yet been approved by the Board, the tentative schedule was carefully selected to avoid conflicts with Cascade races and other club-supported events, as well as local and regional road rallies. Watch for updates after the Board meets in January.

Rally School, six Saturday Series rallies, and Ghouls Gambol all last three to four hours. These rallies start and end in the Portland area. The entry fee is \$25 per team for Cascade members, \$35 per team for nonmembers.

The Mountains to the Sea Rally is an all-day road rally, starting in the Portland area and ending at the beach. The entry fee is \$60 per team for Cascade members, \$85 per team for nonmembers.

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
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
